## Treviglas Academy

After the unfortunate collapse of the sports dome in storms last November, we are pleased the new dome has now been installed. Work will continue this

half term to improve the flooring and equipment and we hope to have it up and running from October half term. The Science labs have had CO<sub>2</sub> ventilation systems installed and gas pipelines have

Meetings continue to coordinate the large scale site refurbishment programme and it is hoped a start on site will be seen in the new year.
